- The proposal must contain **Technical** and **Financial** proposals sealed in **Separate Envelopes**. Both the sealed proposals must be sealed in another single envelope mentioning the **Title** of the Assignment and **RFP (Contract ID) Number**.

 - Proposal (in Hard Copy) must be delivered manually to the address above by **12:00 noon local time** on or before **30th May, 2025**.
 - Received Proposal (**Technical**) shall be opened in the presence of Proponents' representatives who choose to attend at date and time as mentioned in the table above at the office of AEPC, Tahachal, Kathmandu, Nepal
 - The method of selection will be Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS), **70:30** weightage for Technical and Financial proposals respectively.
 - Proposals must be valid for a period of 90 days, counting from the day of Technical Proposal opening.
