The Renewable Energy for Rural Livelihood (RERL) is a joint project of Alternative Energy Promotion Centre (AEPC), Ministry of Energy, Water Resources and Irrigation (MoEWRI) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). RERL is providing technical support to AEPC to implement the Asian Development Bank (ADB) funded South Asia Subregional Economic Cooperation (SASEC) Power System Expansion Project Off-grid Component. AEPC/RERL hereby Requests for Proposal (RFP) from eligible Consulting Firms/Institutions for the task **“Carry out Endline Survey and Conduct Impact Study of 6 Mini Hydropower Subprojects and 4 Solar Minigrids developed under AEPC/SASEC Off Grid Component”**. Other information are as follows:

- The proposal must contain **Technical** and **Financial** proposals sealed in **Separate Envelopes**. Both the sealed proposals must be sealed in another single envelope mentioning the **Title** of the task and **RFP Number**.

- The proposal (in Hard Copy) must be delivered manually to the office of **AEPC/RERL, Khumaltar Height, Lalitpur** by **14:00 hour's local time** on or before **26 December 2025**.
- Received Technical Proposal shall be opened in the presence of Proponents' representatives who choose to attend at **14:30 hour's local time on 26 December 2025** at the office of **AEPC/RERL, Khumaltar Height, Lalitpur, Nepal**.
- The method of selection will be Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS), **70:30** weightage for Technical and Financial proposals respectively.
- Other details are provided in the RFP document.

Note: Weightage for Technical and Financial proposal is revised to 70:30. Interested proponents are requested to prepare and submit the proposals accordingly.
