- The Government of Nepal has received grants from the German Development Cooperation, through KFW
 towards the cost of the Promotion of Solar Energy in Rural and Semi-Urban Regions of Nepal and intends
 to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract.
- 2. Alternative Energy Promotion Centre (AEPC) invites Electronic Bids from registered eligible and qualified Suppliers/Bidders for the task "Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of 2 kWp and 3 kWp Solar Pumping Systems for Irrigation at various beneficiaries of Madhesh Province of Nepal" under National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Single Stage Two Envelope procedures. Bidding is open to all eligible and Qualified Bidders as mentioned in the Bidding Document.
- Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate bids, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid as per the provision of ITB 23 of the Bidding Document.
- Interested Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at the office of AEPC, or may visit the e-GP system of PPMO: www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp.
- Complete set of Bidding Document for the task in English is available online and may be downloaded for e-submission from the e-GP system of PPMO: www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp. Bidders, submitting their bids electronically, should deposit the cost of the Bidding Document (non-refundable fee) of NRs. 5,000.00 in the Rajaswa (Revenue) Bank Account as specified below and a scanned copy in PDF format of the voucher/receipt of the deposited amount must be submitted/uploaded along with the Electronic Bid.

- 6. Pre-bid meeting shall be held at AEPC, Mid-Baneshwor, Kathmandu, Nepal at 11:00 A.M. on 5 May 2024. All questions and their answers discussed during the Pre-Bid meeting will be recorded and provided to all bidders according to the provisions included in 52.2 (2) PPR.
- Interested eligible and qualified Bidders are required to submit the Electronic Bids through the e-GP system of PPMO: www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 12:00 Noon on 19 May 2024.
- 8. Submitted Technical Electronic Bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 12:15 P.M. on 19 May 2024 at the office of AEPC, Mid-Baneshwor, Kathmandu, Nepal. But nothing shall bar the opening of Bids by the reason only that any Bidder or its agent is not present. The bidder's representative should bear with authorization duly signed by the authority of the firm at the time of Bid opening.
- 9. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days counting from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format, amounting to a minimum of NRs. 450,000.00, which shall be valid for a minimum of 30 days beyond the bid validity period (i.e., Valid up to a minimum of 15 September 2024).
- 10. If the bidder wishes to submit the Bid Security in the form of cash, the cash should be deposited in Office Code 3080002 and Account Name DTCO, Kathmandu, Bank Account No. 1201200001002524 at Nepal Rastra Bank, Thapathali and a scanned copy in PDF format of the voucher/receipt of the deposited amount must be submitted/uploaded along with the Electronic Bid.
- 11. If the last date of submission and opening of bids falls on a government/public holiday then the same time of the next working day shall be considered the last day. In such a case the bid validity and bid security validity period shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
- 12. Bidders are advised to visit the site and assess the actual site conditions before submitting their bid. The employer shall not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by bidders in connection with the preparation or submission of Bids.
- The employer reserves the right to accept or reject, wholly or partly any or all the bids without assigning any reason, whatsoever.
